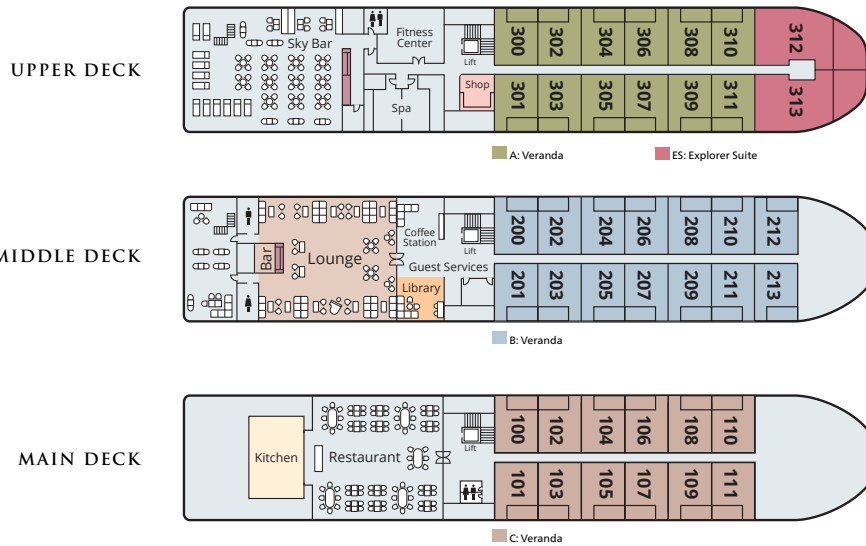
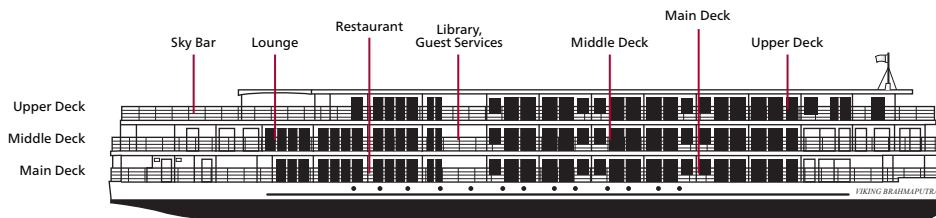

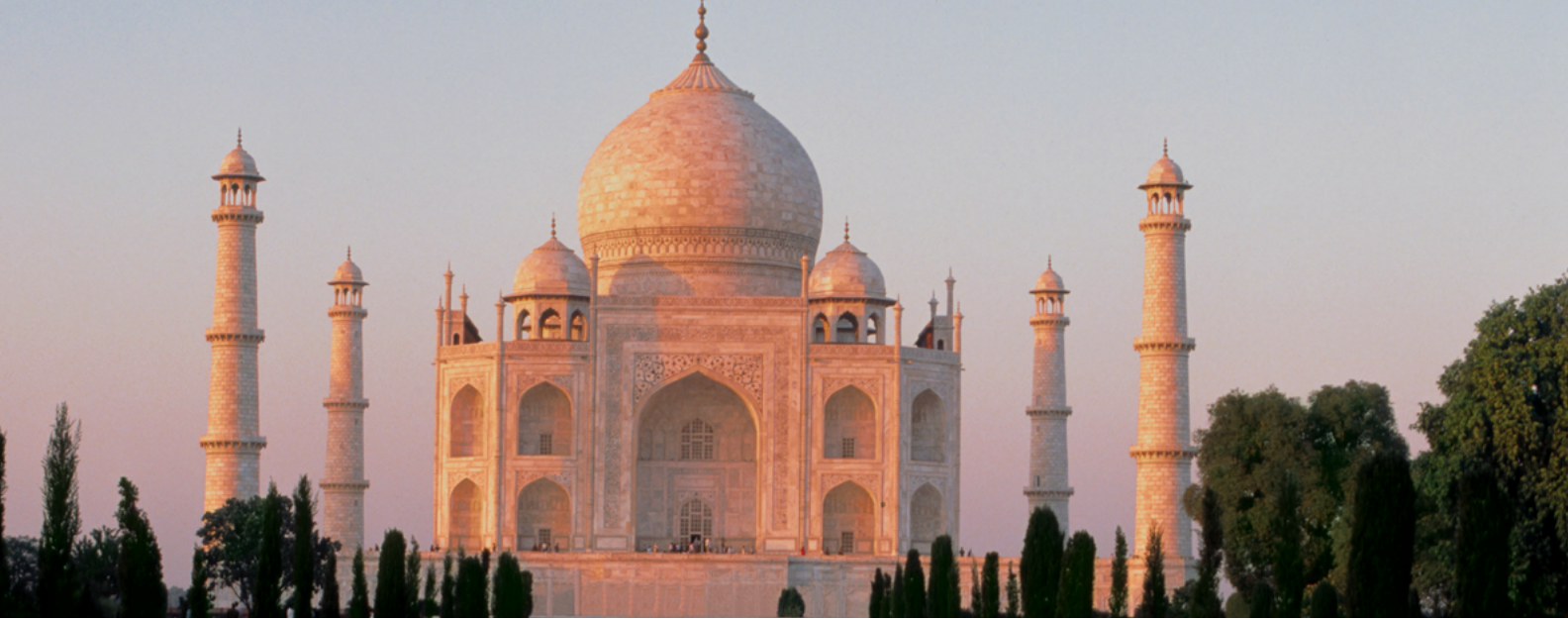

## DELHI

Your journey begins in Delhi, India's dynamic capital. A city of layers, Delhi reveals centuries of history and culture at every turn. Explore Old Delhi by pedicab and experience its energy as you pass vibrant bazaars and narrow winding lanes. Visit the Red Fort, a grand reminder of Mughal rule, and Humayun's Tomb, a stunning UNESCO Site that influenced the design of the Taj Mahal. Stop at the India Gate and admire the broad avenues of New Delhi, designed during the British Raj.

## AGRA

Travel by motor coach to Agra, where the legendary Taj Mahal awaits. Witness this architectural masterpiece at both sunset and sunrise, and watch as the marble shifts in colour with the changing light. Built by Emperor Shah Jahan as a tribute to his beloved wife, the Taj Mahal remains one of the world's most romantic monuments. Explore the Tomb of Itimad-ud-Daulah, often called the "Baby Taj" for its graceful beauty. Consider an optional tour of the formidable Agra Fort, another UNESCO Site.

## JAIPUR

Continue to Jaipur, the "Pink City" of Rajasthan. Along the way, visit UNESCO-listed Fatehpur Sikri, the atmospheric former capital of the Mughal Empire. In Jaipur, tour the Amber Fort, a majestic hilltop palace with ornate interiors and sweeping views. Explore the City Palace complex, still home to the Jaipur royal family, and marvel at the UNESCO-listed Jantar Mantar Observatory, an 18th-century marvel of astronomical instruments. Admire the Palace of the Winds, its honeycomb façade offering a striking example of Rajput architecture.

## GUWAHATI

Fly to Guwahati, gateway to Northeast India and the starting point of your river voyage. Board the elegant *Viking Brahmaputra* and settle in to your stateroom for a relaxing evening. Awake to visit the sacred Kamakhya Temple, perched atop Nilachal Hill, where rituals have been performed for centuries. Take the opportunity to further explore this sprawling riverside city.

## KAZIRANGA NATIONAL PARK

Enjoy the morning sailing as your ship glides through the tranquil landscapes surrounding the Brahmaputra River. This afternoon, join a safari through Kaziranga National Park, a UNESCO Site, for the opportunity to view animals such as swamp deer, monkeys and a variety of birdlife.

## KAZIRANGA NATIONAL PARK

Journey into Kaziranga National Park, a sanctuary for India's famous one-horned rhinoceroses. Join expert naturalists on a jeep safari through the park's grasslands and wetlands, where elephants, water buffalo and Bengal tigers also roam. Birdwatchers may appreciate the park's remarkable variety of species, from storks and pelicans to eagles and hornbills.

## BISWANATH GHAT & MAJULI

Take a brief walk to visit the Gupta Kashi Temple, dating back to the Ahom period, before more scenic sailing. Explore Majuli, the world's largest river island and the cultural heartland of Assam. Visit centuries-old *satras*, or monastic centres, that preserve traditional art, music and spiritual practices. Attend a *gayan-bayan* performance, a devotional dance, and meet artisans who keep ancient techniques in mask-making, pottery and weaving alive.

## NIMATI GHAT

Step ashore at Nimati Ghat to uncover the ruins of the Ahom Kingdom, which ruled Assam for nearly six centuries. Wander among temples and palaces that reflect a rich fusion of indigenous and Hindu influences. This peaceful site offers a contemplative look into the region's past.
